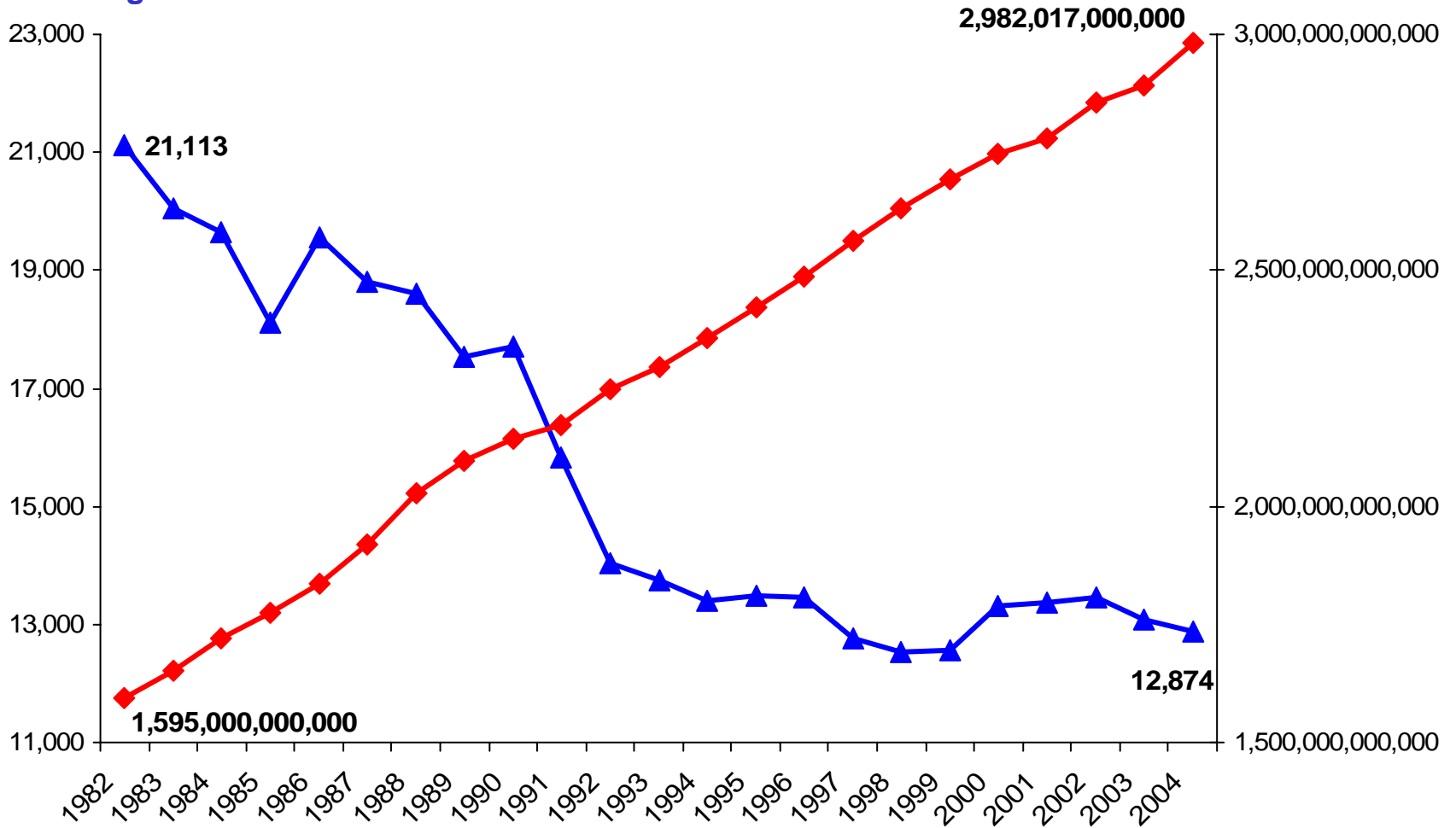


Total Drunk-Driving Fatalities Down 39% Despite an 87% Increase in Vehicle Miles Traveled

Total Fatalities in Drunk Driving Crashes

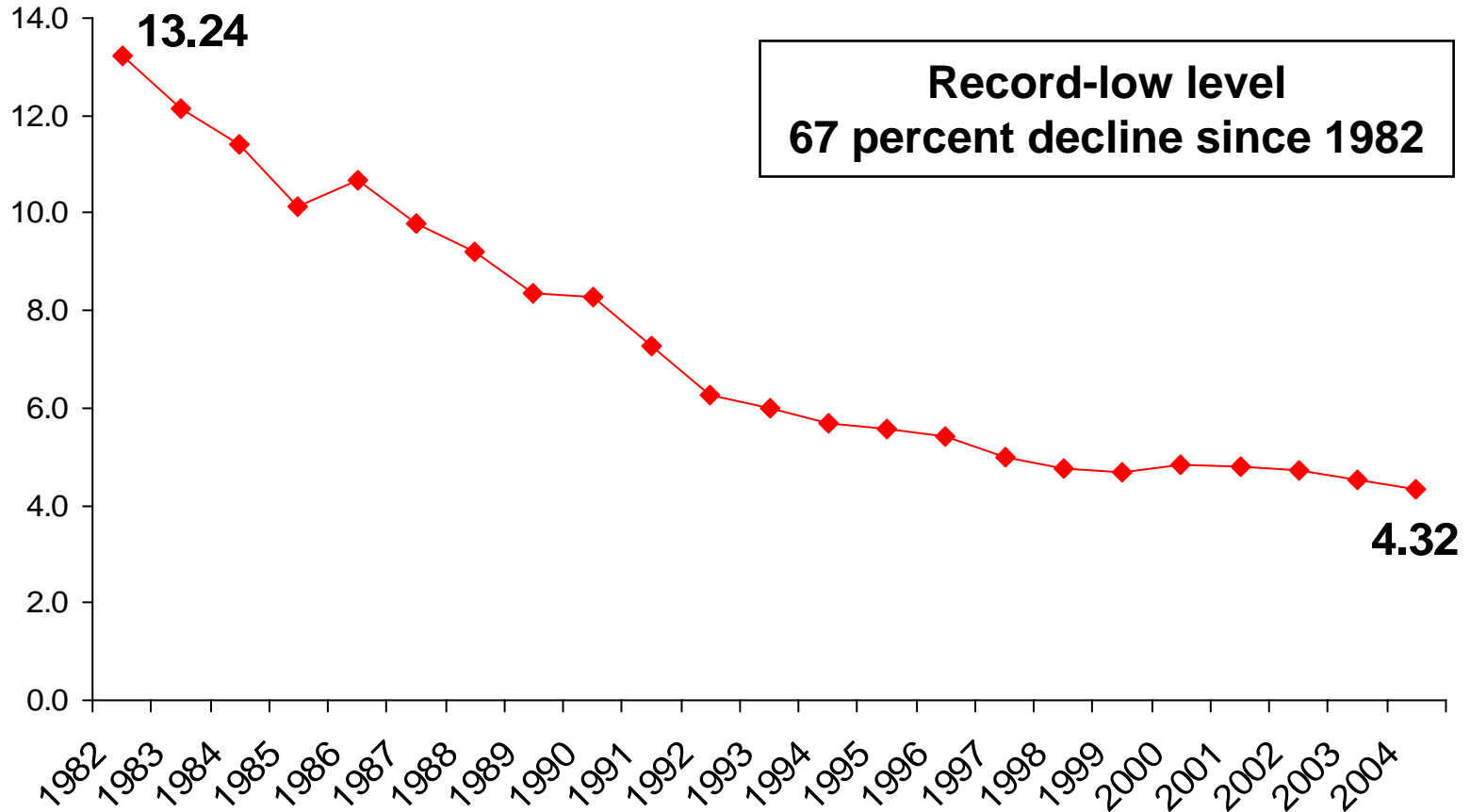
Vehicle Miles Traveled

Total Drunk-Driving Fatalities Per Billion Vehicle Miles Traveled



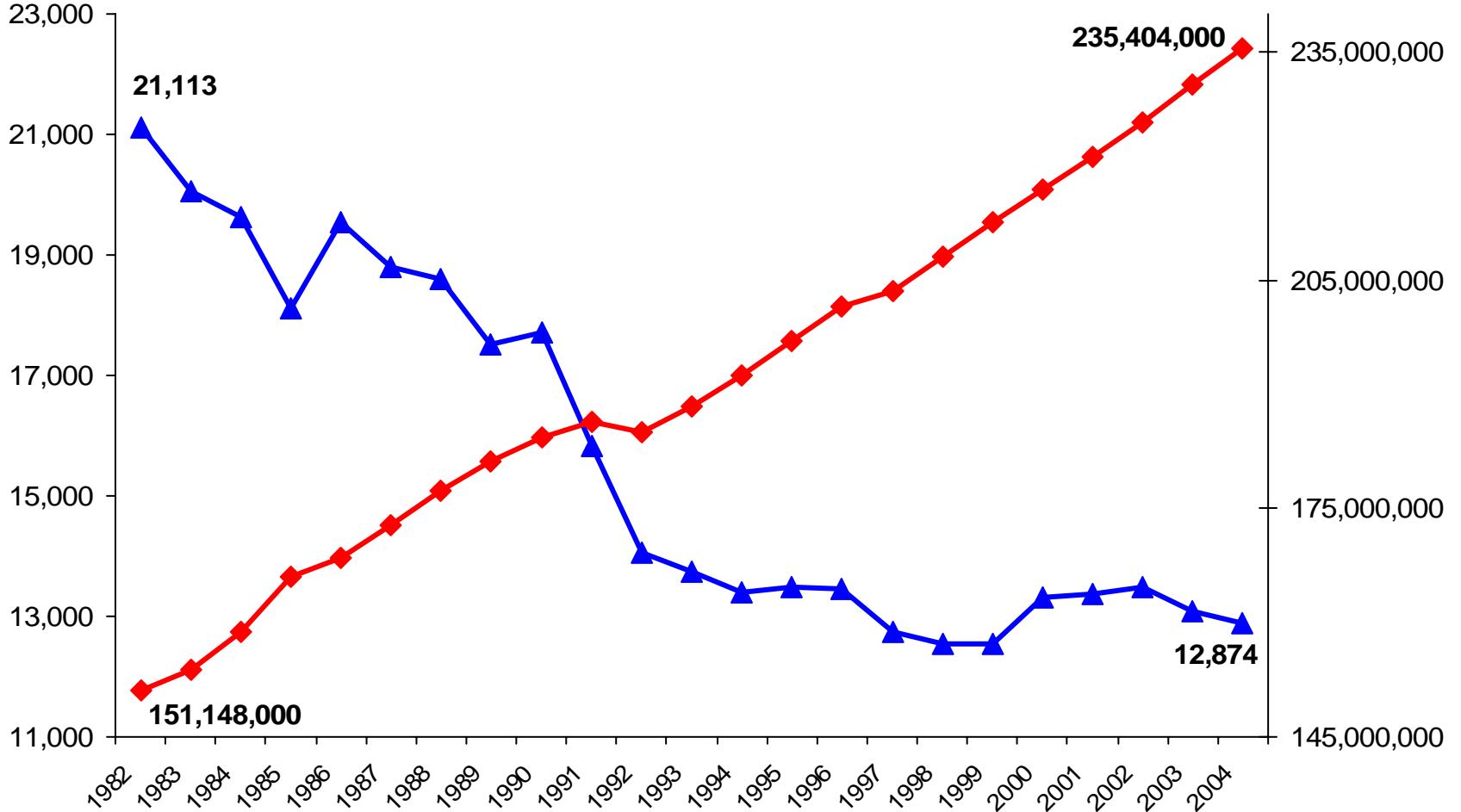

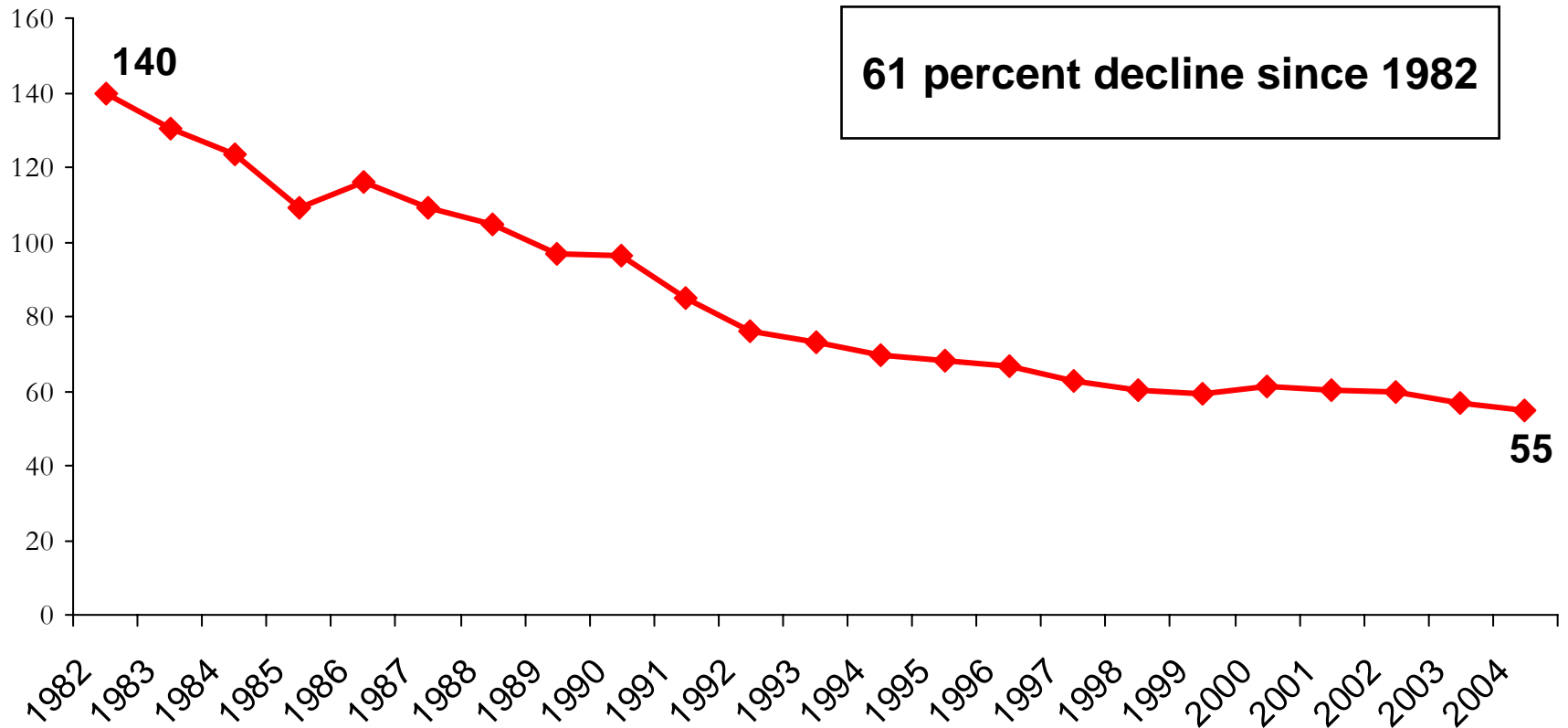

Total Drunk-Driving Fatalities Per Million Registered Motor Vehicles

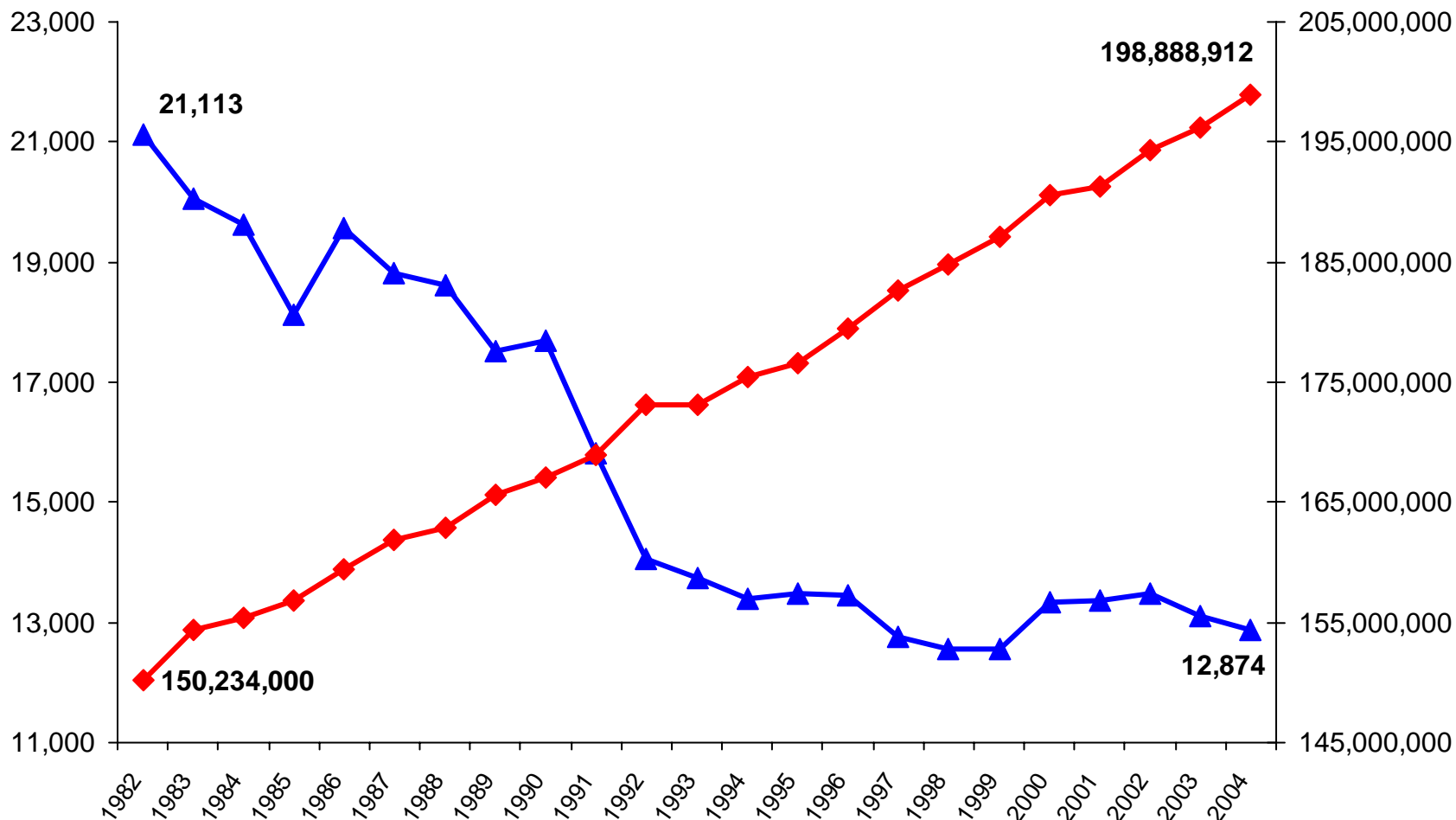

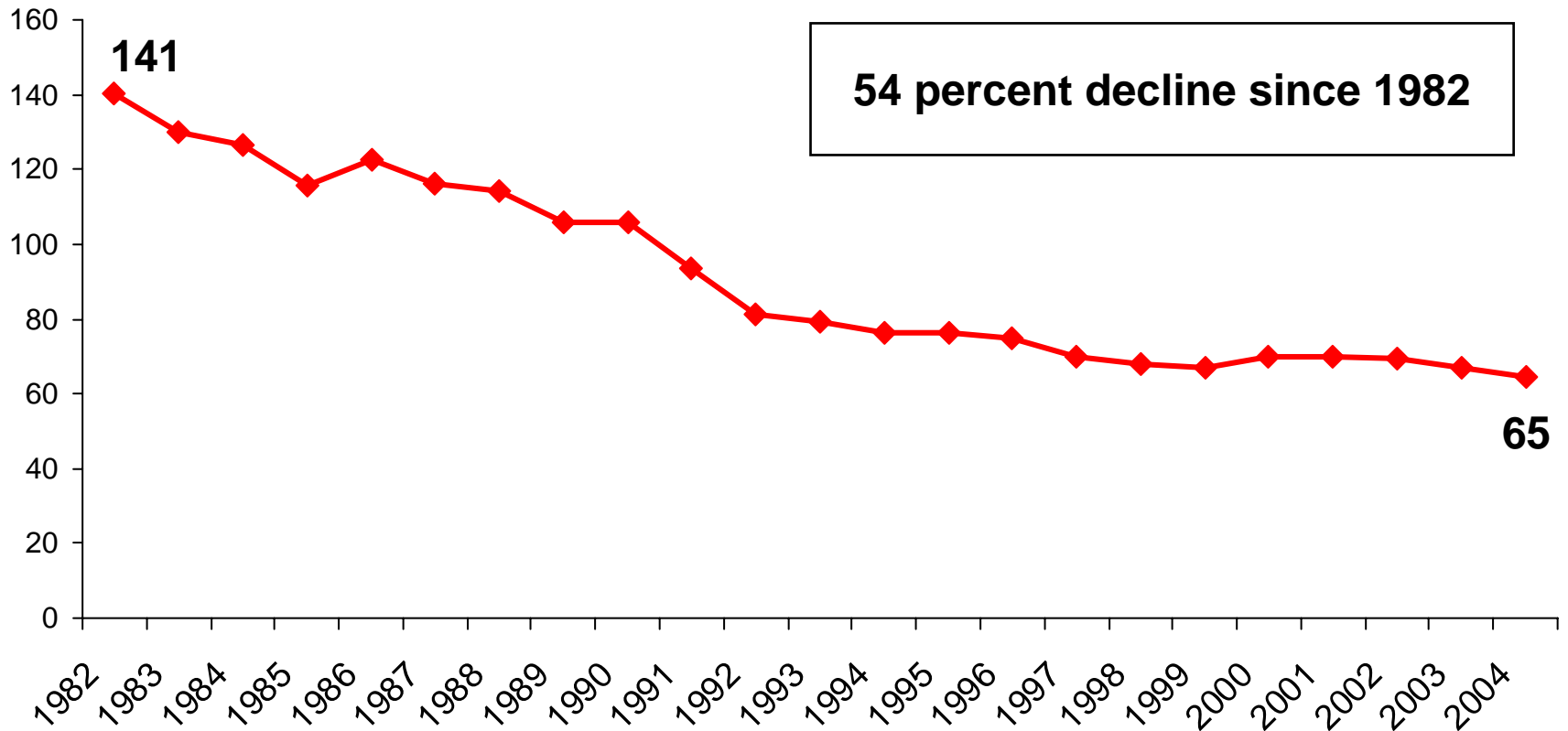

Total Drunk-Driving Fatalities Per Million Licensed Drivers



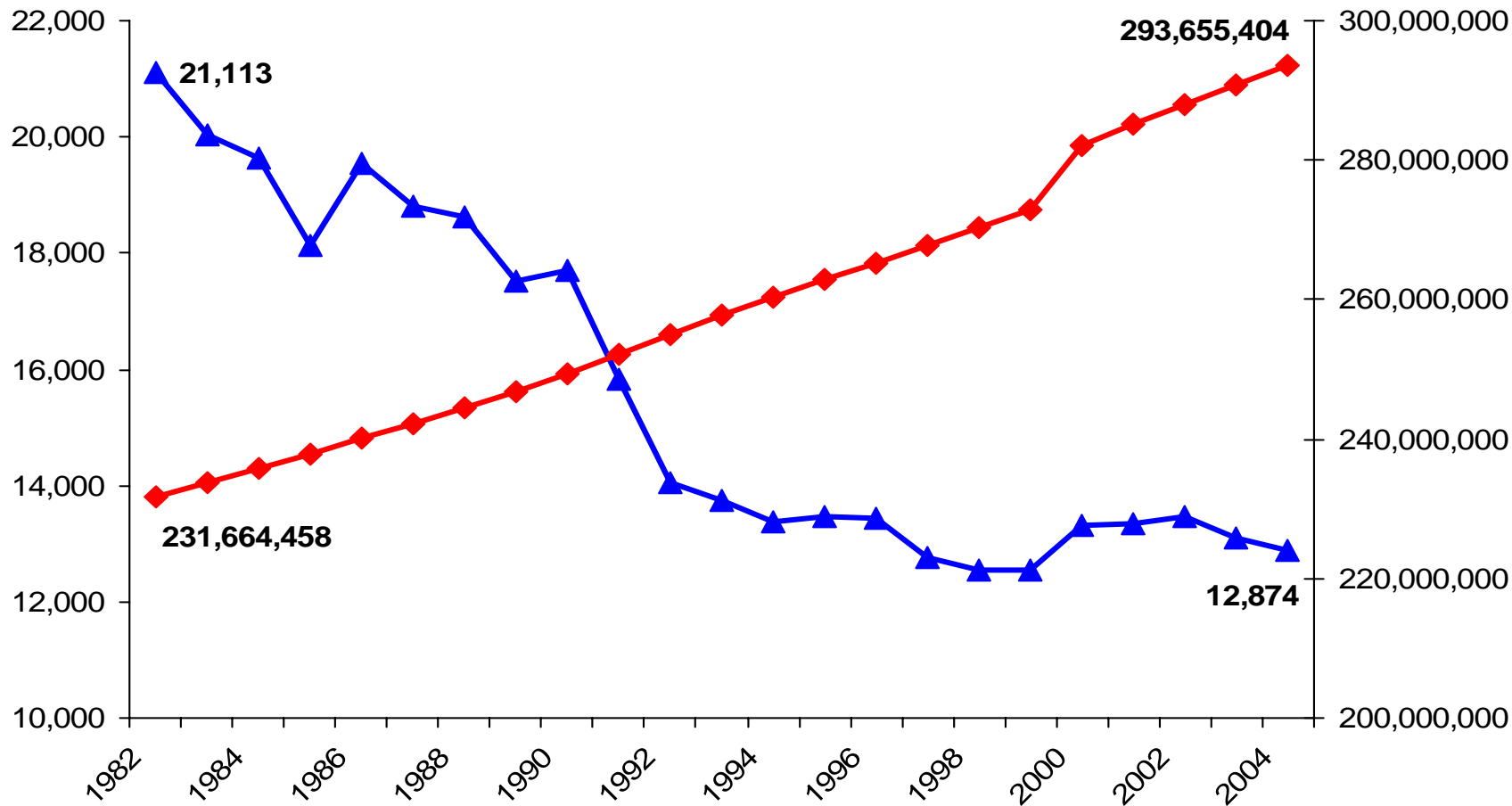

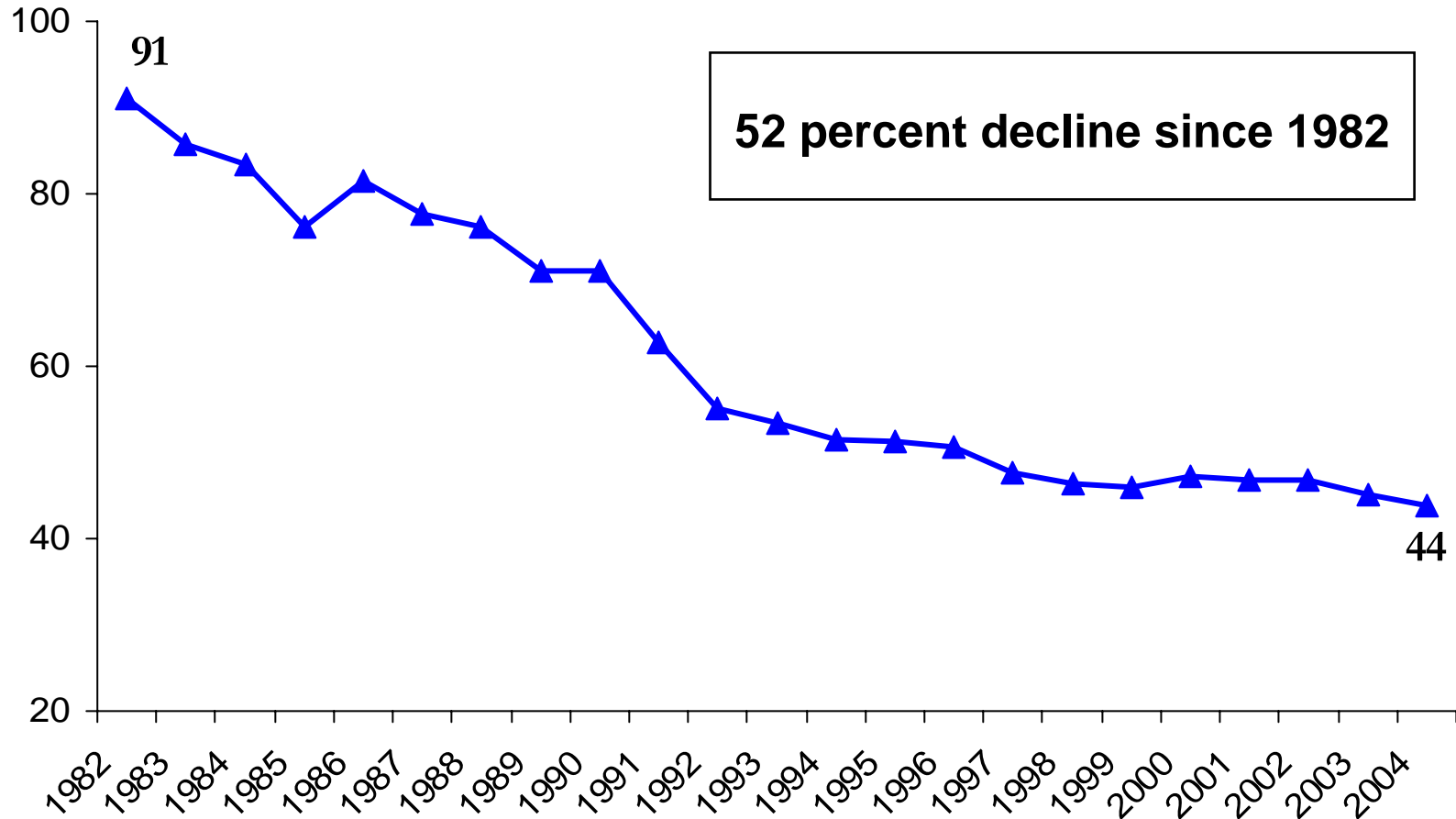
Total Fatalities in Drunk Driving Crashes
