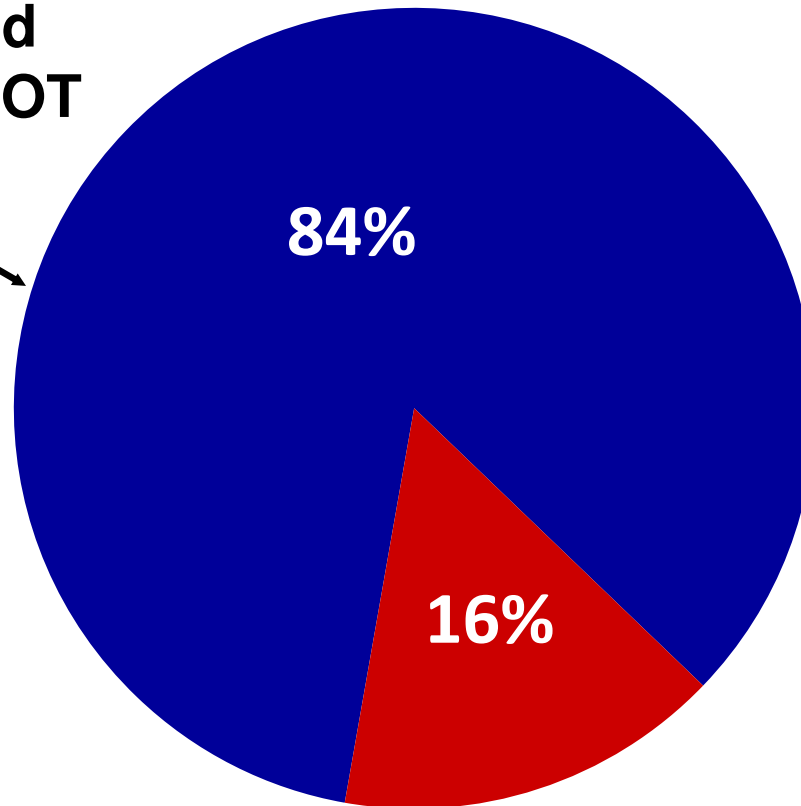


National Survey on Drug Use and Health Heavy Drinking Among Full-time Undergraduates 18-22 Year-Olds

**84% of 18-22 year-old
undergraduates are NOT
heavy drinkers**



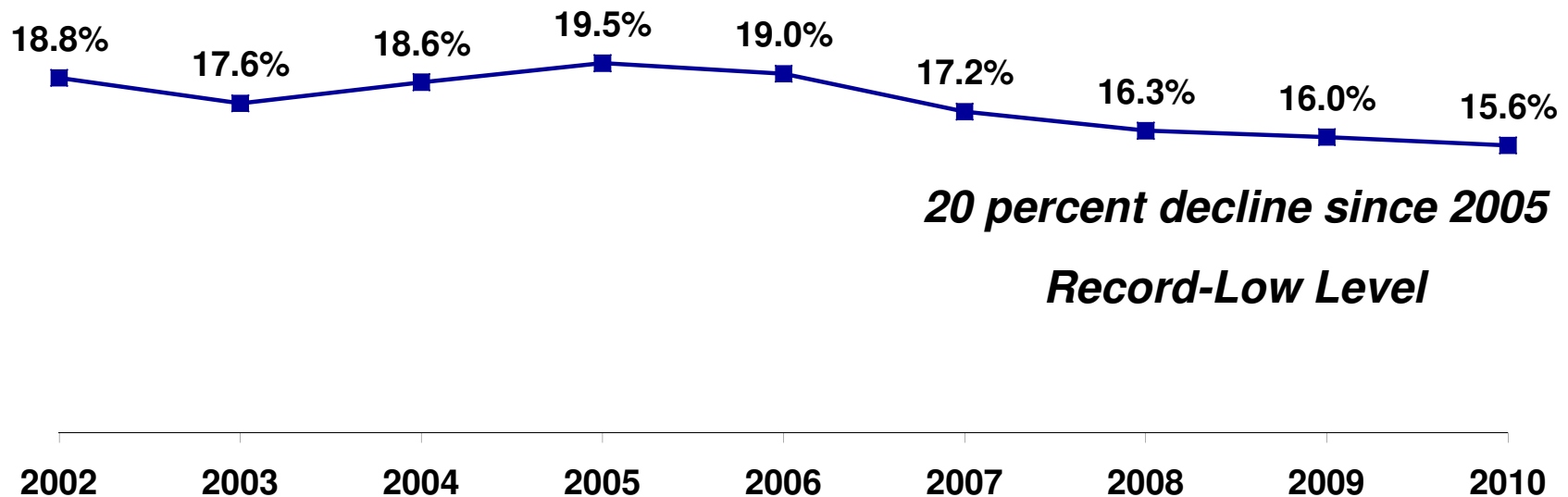

The 2010 survey is based on interviews with approximately 67,500 respondents ages 12 and older. The survey covers residents of households (living in houses/townhouses, apartments, condominiums, etc.), persons in noninstitutional group quarters (e.g., shelters, rooming/boarding houses, college dormitories, migratory workers' camps, halfway houses), and civilians living on military bases.

Heavy Alcohol Use is defined as drinking five or more drinks on the same occasion on each of 5 or more days in the past 30 days.

Question: During the past 30 days, on how many days did you drink 5 or more drinks on the same occasion? By 'occasion' we mean at the same time or within a couple of hours of each other.
